**Some of the results:**

1 October 2019 – 30 September 2022

- Three short presentations given by the OUC professors at UPB in October 2019
- Development of two new disciplines: “Information and Communications Technology Entrepreneurship” for master programs in the management domain and “Information and Communications Technology based Innovation” for master programs in the computer science domain
- The disciplines were developed collaboratively by experts in particular subjects
- Training of two Romanian professors at OUC
- Set of a bilateral Erasmus Plus Agreement between UPB and OUC
- Research mobility for 8 Romanian students at OUC. Because of the pandemic and political conditions, the mobilities were developed online
- Writing of five joint research papers



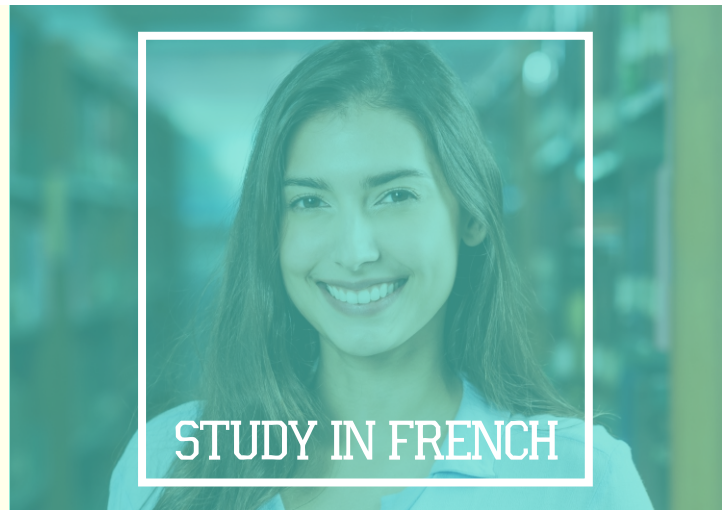
